Tasting Notes: The aromas have a moderate to high intensity of ripe stone fruits, honeycomb, and white flowers. This is a complex wine with intense flavor of peach and apricots. Long finish dominated by mineral notes and citrus. After gently crushing and pressing the free run juice ferments in stainless steel tanks and matures Sur Lie for 4 months. The 10% of the production remains for around 6 - 7 months in French oak barrels.
