Tasting Notes: This is a beautifully crafted wine made from a 70/30 blend. It was aged 12 months in new French oak. All the intensity of Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah in full force. Its color is a dense, dark ruby red. A complex, delicious wine, packed with the aromas of a very diverse bouquet: marmalades of dark fruits, black cherries, sour cherries, liquorice, peppery notes, and cocoa, with hints tarragon. A wine that can be cellared, ready to generously reward any who have the patience to wait..
