

Plano Malagousia

Producer: Wine Art Estate Vintage: 2023

Tasting Notes: A balanced and at the same time expressive Malagousia from Wine Art Estate. This wine is the benchmark for Malagousia. On the nose, intense character that brings a Mediterranean garden with green herbs to mind. Citrus fruits, unripe peach and a wonderful green character reminiscent of green pepper, freshly cut grass, fennel and mint. Cold soaking of the skins prior to fermentation to transfer aroma components from the grapes to the must. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks with "batonnage sur lies" (stirring of the fine lees into the tanks) for a month; a method that gives the wine volume and complexity.

This wine can handle dishes with intense flavors and spices therefore ideal for Latin, Cajun or Asian cuisine.
